

SUMMER SCHOOL 2008 DATA UPDATE

Summary:

As of April 29, 2008, 45 official summer school sites are available in 2008 for students statewide. This figure is based on actual Site Notification forms received by the summer school office. Official summer school sites are the sites operating under the Department of Education Summer School guidelines with legal authority from:

- Board of Education Policy 2410 – Summer School Programs,
- Hawaii Administrative Rules Title 8 Subtitle 2, Part I, Chapter 30 Public Summer School Tuition, and
- Department of Education Regulations:
 - 2410.1 - Regular and Special Education Summer School Programs
 - 5108 - General Conditions of Recruitment, Selection and Appointment Administrative Regulations
 - 5203 - Compensation Administrative Regulations

The 45 official summer school sites are located on the following islands:

- Oahu -12 elementary, 6 middle/intermediate, 13 high schools, 1 elementary/middle/high school, 2 middle/high school, 1 on-line school for middle/high school
- Hawaii – 3 elementary, 2 high schools
- Maui – 1 middle/intermediate
- Kauai – 1 elementary, 3 high schools.

Attachment A – *Official Summer School Sites - 2008* provides an updated listing of official summer school sites by district, levels (elementary, middle, high school), grade levels served, summer school program dates, daily time frame, tuition, etc.

The current number of official sites is expected to increase as schools evaluate student needs and interests and determine self-supporting programs to meet student needs and interests. (As schools continue to submit data, this report will be updated.)

Attachment B – Extended Learning Opportunity Programs Offered During Summer 2008 provides a listing of schools that provide extended learning opportunities designed specifically for students enrolled at their schools during the period from the end of one official school year to the beginning of the next official school year. These extended learning opportunity programs are not official summer school sites because the specialized programs--i.e., enrichment, recovery, and recreational sports programs are not offered to the public or

students outside of their school attendance area, nor are fees assessed. These schools are not required to submit a Summer School 2008 Official Site Notification Form and do not necessarily follow the legal authorities listed above. However, all other Department policies and regulations apply and the programs are under the oversight of the school principals in accordance with Act 51.

The extended learning opportunity programs are primarily funded through grants from the Department of Human Services, Act 281 - Non-School Hour Program, and/or parent / community organizations. Fifteen Oahu schools (9 elementary, 6 high schools) and four Hawaii schools (3 elementary, 1 high school) have indicated that they may be offering extended learning opportunities to their students during the summer 2008 break. Six of the schools funded through non-school hour grants in SY 2007-2008 are offering summer school programs or extended learning opportunity programs.

In addition, Uniting Peer Learning, Integrating New Knowledge (UPLINK) programs are being offered at 13 middle and intermediate schools throughout the state—eight on Oahu, one on Hawaii, three on Maui, and one on Kauai. UPLINK schools are federally-funded middle schools that feed into high schools with high teen pregnancy rates. The schools offer a wide variety of activities and programs that develop student awareness of teen pregnancy issues, build basic skills, and support student interest and enrichment.

Furthermore some schools may offer programs or tuition assistance during the summer for Migrant Education Summer School Instruction through the Migrant Education office.

As more data is submitted to our office, this report will also be updated.
