VENUE: Dowsett Pool at Hawaii Preparatory Academy, 65-1692 Kohala Road, Kamuela, HI 96743

**COURSE:** 8 lanes, 25y x 25m facility set for SCY 25y racing course. Minimum Racing Start depth 4"0". Turn Depth 4'0". The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4).

### SCHEDULE: Warm-Ups: 8:15 AM TO 9:15 AM. Races Start: 9:30 AM.

**Teams will be assigned warm-up times for both days**. Scheduled warm-up times will be sent to all teams on Thursday, May 30, 2013. The following are the group warm-up times:

**RULES:** The meet will be conducted in accordance with current USA Swimming and Hawaiian Swimming rules. The Meet Marshals, with concurrence of the Meet Referee, shall have full authority to remove or have removed from the vicinity of the competition anyone whose behavior or actions are unsafe or are disrupting the orderly conduct of the meet, including the disqualification of athletes from competition.

FORMAT: Timed finals for all events. Seeded and swum slowest to fastest.

TIMING: Automatic timing system with manual backup.

**DIVISIONS:** 8 & Under, 10 & Under, 11-12, 13-14, 15-16, 17-18. Relay events 10 & Under, 12 & Under, Open. Divisions may be swum combined with results ranked separately by age group.

EVENT SCHEDULE: See attached list of events.

**ELIGIBILITY:** No swimmer who is not a member as provided in Article 302 will be allowed to compete or participate except as provided under 202.6 or USA Swimming's "open border" policy included in its Registration Manual. The registration number of each athlete must be included in the entry file. All NEW registrations (including registration fee) must be mailed directly by each Club Registrar to the LSC Registrar. New registrations must be POSTMARKED NO LATER than the registration deadline. No deck registration will be accepted. It is the legal responsibility of each club to ensure that each athlete entered is USA Swimming registered for the current year.

ENTRY LIMITS: Athletes may enter a maximum of four (4) individual events plus one (1) relay per day.

**ENTRY PROCEDURES:** Entries must be RECEIVED NO LATER than the entry deadline. No late entries will be accepted at the meet. Entries must be submitted electronically and include: 1. Exported entry file using Hy-Tek Team Manager or other SD3 compatible program. 2. "Team Report" with coach and entry person contact information, and 3. "Entry Fees Report".

**ENTRY FEES:** \$2.00 per individual event and \$5.00 per relay team. Entry fees must accompany entries OR be submitted to Clerk of Course upon check-in. No refunds will be made. Make checks payable to: **Hawaii Preparatory Academy.**

**SCRATCHES**: Scratches are due to the Clerk of Course one (1) hour before the scheduled start of the session. Coaches are to present their credentials to the Clerk of Course to pick up scratch sheets and heat sheets. Exceptions must see the Meet Referee.

WARM-UPS: Warm-ups must be supervised by a USA swimming registered Coach Member following guidelines established by the LSC. Supervising coaches must have their USA Swimming Registration Card displayed at all times. The Meet Marshals will enforce the warm-up procedures and maintain order in the swimming venue. Disregard of USA Swimming safety rules will be grounds for disqualification of athletes from competition. Warm-up lanes may be assigned by the Meet Director.



**RACING STARTS:** Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

**AWARDS:** Individuals will be awarded ribbons for 1st through 8th place in each age group division and each classification as defined in the Order of Events. Relay teams will be awarded ribbons for 1<sup>st</sup> through 3rd for the following divisions: 10 & Under, 12 & Under, 13-18.

**RESULTS:** Final Results will be posted on the Hawaiian Swimming website: <u>www.hawaiianswimming.org</u>. Meet results including TM files will be emailed to head coaches.

**OFFICIALS:** Key officials will be assigned their duties prior to the meet. Each club is required to provide one (1) official for every five (5) athletes entered in the meet. For clubs entered with less than five (5) athletes, at least one (1) official will be required. Timers are considered officials. All officials, timers, and marshals report to the Meet Referee.

**Note:** Additionally, the Big Island Swimming Delegates (members from each Hawaii Island swim team) agreed that EACH TEAM IS REQUIRED TO PROVIDE AT LEAST ONE DECK OFFICIAL PER MEET. Teams are to e-mail the meet referee, with a list of deck officials that will be available to work at the meet.

HOSPITALITY: Refreshments will be available for Officials and Coaches during the meet.

**CONCESSION:** Concession will be available during the meet.

## **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

- EXCEPT WHERE VENUE FACILITIES REQUIRE OTHERWISE, CHANGING INTO OR OUT OF SWIMSUITS OTHER THAN IN LOCKER ROOMS OR OTHER DESIGNATED AREAS IS NOT APPROPRIATE AND IS PROHIBITED.
- USA-S Rule 102.8 D will be enforced: Swimsuits worn for competition must be non-transparent and conform to the current concept of the appropriate.
- USE OF AUDIO OR VISUAL RECORDING DEVICES, INCLUDING A CELL PHONE, IS NOT PERMITTED IN CHANGING AREAS, RESTROOMS, OR LOCKER ROOMS.
- NO PHOTOGRAPHY BEHIND THE STARTING AREA(S).
- LOCKER ROOMS coaches are responsible for the behavior and actions of their swimmers while in the locker rooms and the pool/athletics areas. It is critical that ALL Big Island Swimming athletes conduct themselves in a civil manner and respect the property of others.
- Animals or pets are NOT allowed on campus. Service animals with certification are allowed. Big Island Swimming will not tolerate and/or be responsible for any actions or negative impact resulting from the animal. Further, if the animal is deemed disruptive, for any reason, it will have to be immediately removed from the premises.
- SWIMMERS MUST BE SUPERVISED BY THEIR COACH AT ALL TIMES.
- CLIMBING OR SITTING ON ROCK WALLS IS PROHIBITED.
- HPA SCHOOL, BIG ISLAND SWIMMING, HAWAIIAN SWIMMING AND POOL RULES WILL BE ENFORCED.

It is understood and agreed that USA Swimming shall be free from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event.
